[Guideline to video recording]

- \*The camera angle should remain fixed and the video should be shot from the front.
- \*When filming, the performer's full body should be visible at 3/4 of the size of the screen.
- \*Keep the music stand low so that your hands are visible.
- ★No editing is allowed within one piece.
- \*If each piece is filmed separately, please combine them into one URL.
- \*Utmost care must be taken so that there will be no background noise.
- \*Be sure to check the overall image and sound quality before submitting. (If the video cannot be played, it will be considered as not submitted.)
  - ★Result of the Document / Video Screening will be sent on <u>Thursday</u>, <u>February</u> 19, 2026 by email. (1st round audition schedule, set piece and the orchestra excerpts will be notified to the successful applicants.)
